Challenge #1 | River City Kids

"I knew we shouldn't have come today"

- Number of Kids born/adopted in 2020-2022
 - o 15 (2020), 19 (2021), 9 (as of Sept 2022)
 - o Total in 3 years: 43
- Kids currently in RC Kids (3 year span for each classroom)
 - o Nursery: ~10 (max 12-14 per service)
 - o Preschool: ~17 (max 12-14 per service)
 - o Elementary: ~18 (max 12-14 per service)
- Lack of security/too much access to classrooms →
- Lots of young families attending (opposite of current national trends)

Challenge #2 | River City Institute

- 9 students currently
- Very low cost to students (low barrier to entry) \$500/semester
- Goal of 8-12 per semester in future
- Feeds into church planting
- Currently, much of Pastor Devin's time spent on River City Institute
 - Funded by River City regular giving
- Needing to setup and tear down every week in worship space
- Limited office space for work/study















The Solution | Building Project (1st Floor)





Benefits of Building Project

- Solves RC Kids space needs
- Increases security of kids space
- Space for River City Institute during week
- Increases office space (staff, pastoral residents, planters)
- Allows for expansion of worship space
- Opens current classrooms during services for classes & training

- Gives space to establish a hub for church planting and revitalization in our region (host conferences, training, work space, etc)
- Space for other ministries to utilize (FCA/CRU/etc.)
- Opens opportunities for more community service engagement (food/water distribution, emergency shelter space, etc.)

An Opportunity to Join Us

Total Fundraising Goal: \$1 Million

 \$850,000 was building project estimate in 2021. Expecting increase in costs (inflation) and padding for problems encountered

Target Date: May 2023

Stretch Goal: \$1.5M

- \$320,000 for paying off current mortgage
